These lesson plans are designed as follow up activities based on a Passover theme. Feel free to expand on the lessons, and be creative! Remember, the point of doing a lesson is to convey information in a way that will help your children/students understand and retain the material presented.

Lesson Plans Passover

Lesson 1: Culture

Objective: To understand why people celebrate ending slavery

Materials needed: Passover book

Procedure: Describe what is to be a slave. Have your students make pairs and give each other a task they don't like doing. Have them repeat it over and over. This will help them understand the concept of slavery.

Follow Up: Why is good to be free? Write a paragraph about being free.

Lesson 2: Cultural Foods

Objective: Having the students understand why traditional foods are important.

Materials needed: Passover book, blindfold, and a variety of foods.

Procedure: Have your students taste various foods and describe how each food makes them feel. Have them also talk about how certain foods remind them of special occasions.

Follow up: Have students bring in unique cultural food from their homes, and ask them to describe the food, as well as what makes it "cultural".
