Lesson Plans
St. Patrick's Day

Lesson #1

Objective: To talk about what we see during the St. Patrick's Day season.

Materials: The St. Patrick's Day book, fliers from stores, photos from home during St. Patrick's Day.

Procedure: Have your students find and label things that appear during the St. Patrick's Day holiday. Make sure to point out the difference between what you do and don't see during the season.

Follow up: Have students talk about unique things that they have in their homes during St. Patrick's Day.

Lesson #2

Objective: Making a word web or collage.

Materials: Fliers from stores, old St. Patrick's Day cards, photos from home during St. Patrick's Day, construction paper, scissors, & glue.

Procedure: Have your students find, cut and past St. Patrick's Day relate pictures into a word web or collage.

Follow up: Have students talk about unique things that they have in their homes during St. Patrick's Day, and the St Patrick's Day Parade!

Lesson #3

Objective: Diverse foods for different seasons.

Materials: The St. Patrick's Day book, fliers from stores, photos from home during St. Patrick's Day.



Procedure: Have your students talk about what things people eat during the St. Patrick's Day season that is different than the rest of the year. What are some special foods they look forward to in their homes?

Follow up: Have students bring in special holiday recipes that are special to their families.
