Lesson Plans Butterfly

Lesson 1: Sequencing/Life Cycle

Objective: To understand making a sequence and the life cycle of a butterfly.

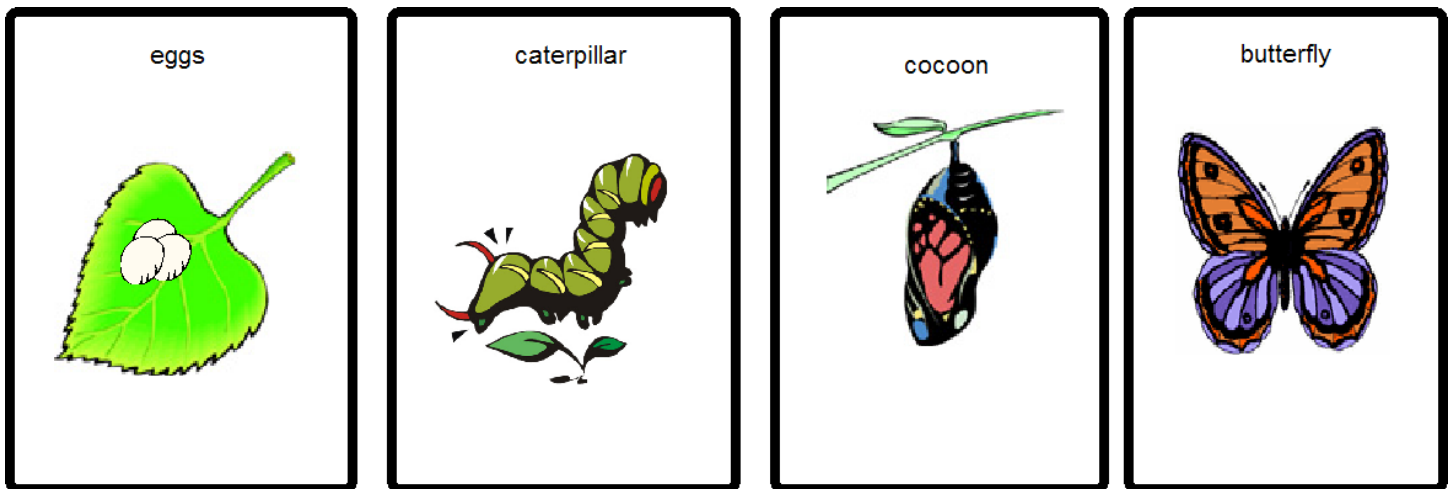
Materials needed: Butterfly book, sequence cards (attached below).

Procedure: Have the students use the card to talk about the life cycle.

1. Lay out cards
2. Have students put them in the correct order.
3. Mix up the cards.
4. repeat

Talk about why things have specific cycles and times that they happen.

Follow Up: Timing. Using an egg timer, see how fast you can sequence the cards from start to finish.
