Lesson Plans Chanukah

Lesson #1

Objective: To talk about what we see during the Chanukah season.

Materials: The Chanukah book, fliers from stores, photos from home during Chanukah.

Procedure: Have your students find and label things that appear during the Chanukah season. Make sure to point out the difference between what you do and don't see during the season.

Follow up: Have students talk about unique things that they have in their homes during Chanukah.

Lesson #2

Objective: Making a word web or collage.

Materials: Fliers from stores, old Chanukah cards, photos from home during Chanukah, construction paper, scissors, & glue.

Procedure: Have your students find, cut and past Chanukah pictures into a word web or collage.

Follow up: Have students talk about unique things that they have in their homes during Chanukah.

Lesson #3

Objective: Diverse foods for different seasons.

Materials: The Chanukah book, fliers from stores, old Chanukah cards, photos from home during Chanukah.



Procedure: Have your students talk about what things people eat during the Chanukah season that is different than the rest of the year. What are some special foods they look forward to in their homes?

Follow up: Have students bring in special holiday recipes that are special to their families.
