These lesson plans are designed as follow up activities based on the theme of Community Helpers. Feel free to expand on the lessons, and be creative! Remember, the point of doing a lesson is to convey information in a way that will help your children/students understand and retain the material presented.

### **Community Helpers Lesson Plans**

#### **Lesson plan 1:**

##### **Objective:**

Understanding community helpers.

##### **Materials:**

Community Helpers book, large paper, fliers, magazines.

##### **Procedure:**

After reading the book, look through fliers and magazines. How many pictures can you find of community helpers? Label the community helpers on the large paper and see how many you can come up with.

##### **Follow up questions:**

How many of the pictures you found were advertisements? How many pictures in magazines had articles about them? Why do you think that is?

#### **Lesson plan 2:**

##### **Objective:**

Having students understand what equipment community helpers need to do their jobs.

##### **Materials:**

Community Helpers book.

##### **Activity:**

Print out the icons from the Community Helpers book, and mix them up. Have each student or group of students look at the pictures. Ask what kind of equipment each community helper needs. Make a list, and count how much equipment that can add up to!



**Follow up questions:**

Do any of the community helpers use the same equipment? Why or why not? Can you think of any way to help to help community helpers like firemen and policemen get things they need?
